

## Quilters Making Dresses for Kids in Need

We are happy to report that over 100 "Shoebox" pillowcase dresses have been made over approximately the last 3 months. You also can make the dresses- and many have been do-ing these at home using materials that the members have donated.

We still have an ongoing need for the following items to make pillowcase dresses:

- **At least half-inch wide rick-rack or lace**
- **Pillowcases (any size)**
- **Half-inch, extra-wide, double-fold bias tape**

As far as quilts go, so far 14-20 quilts have been distributed this year and 20 more are complete and ready for distribution. Quilters meet once a month on the first Tuesday at 9:30AM in Luther Hall and will con-tinue to do so in 2016.

**We are still looking for bed sheets (gently used) for backing and square for the quilts and clothes hangers to display and store quilts and dresses.**
